### **Air Quality Index Based on Particulate Matters 2.5 (PM2.5) and 10 (PM10) Concentration**

**Air quality category:** Moderate

**Location:** Antigua and Barbuda

**Timing:** Saturday afternoon until Tuesday

**Synopsis:** The air quality to fall to moderate levels as a result of particulate matters 2.5 and 10, associated with a fresh surge in the Saharan Dust. The threat of health problems is elevated, for mainly unusually sensitive people, such as asthmatics and could potentially cause them limited health impacts.

**Air quality index:** 50 to 80

**Alert Level:** II

**Sensitive groups:** People with respiratory or heart disease, the elderly and children are the groups most at risk.

**Health implications:** Air quality is acceptable; however, for some pollutants, there may be moderate health concerns for a very small number of people who are unusually sensitive to air pollution.

**Caution:** Active children and adults, and people with respiratory diseases, such as asthma, should limit prolonged outdoor exertion.
